2024 Chino Valley Territorial Days Car Show Rules

- Only cars and truck manufactured prior to 1975 are allowed to compete.
- Limited to the first 125 paid entries.
- First 50 paid entries will receive preferential parking.
- Early entry is \$35, entries submitted after August 4 is \$40.
- Early entries must be submitted with payment by August 4, 2024.
- All other entries will park on a first come first serve basis, outside of the preferential area.
- Groups or clubs wanting to park together, must submit entries as a package.
- Cars may arrive to stage at 7AM the day of show, we ask that all entries remain until 1PM.
- Individual class winners will be chosen by a panel of judges, all decisions are final.
- Only paid entries will be allowed in the show area, all others must park in public areas.
- The revving of engines will be kept to a minimum and not more than once every hour (cars wishing to rev engines are asked to park in the perimeter areas as to not disturb others.
- Each paid entry will receive one ballot to vote for best of show at time of check in. Ballot must be submitted by 12PM.

<u>CLASSES AND AWARDS</u>

<u>Cruiser:</u> This is our version of a "Stock" class. Defined as cars or trucks with minimal engine modifications (dress up kits are allowed), no body modifications. Paint and wheel modifications are allowed. There will be two awards for CRUISER, "Early" (pre-1960) and "Late" (1960 through 1974).

<u>Hot Rod:</u> Defined as any car or truck that does not meet the Cruiser class. There will also be two awards for Hot Rod, "Early" (pre-1960) and "Late" (1960-1974).

Best Paint: One award

Best Interior: One Award

Foundation Award: Selected by the Chino Valley Memorial Foundation's Board

<u>Best of Show:</u> Each Paid entry will receive a ballot at time of check in. Winner will be chosen by the show participants.
